- 8.1) Please provide any comments you would like to make:
- Candace really wants her students to learn the material. She is a fair grader and will try to make time to meet with you when needed. I asked to meet before a quiz and she definitely tried to fit me in even though she had classes and other things to do before going to our MATH 170 class. Definitely recommend her to others; sweet and caring lady!
- Candace was a good teacher, she taught well and wanted us to succeed. My only complaint is that she often would start quizzes with only a few minutes to spare in the class, so everyone was late getting out. In a class that already runs until 7:15, this was an issue for many students.
- I had to retake this course after some intense extenuating circumstances caused me to fall behind in class, where my professor was already difficult to follow, inflexible, and detached. By contrast, Candace is the best math teacher I have ever had at USC. She began every class by explaining what we were going to do that day and then stuck to it. She laid out material in a logical, consistent, easy to follow way. She spoke loudly and clearly. She put herself in the position of non-math majors approaching the subject, asked questions to learn why we did not understand particular things, and then incorporated that feedback into her teaching strategy. She did not allow students to get lost. She regularly checked in with the class to make sure that everyone was following along. She encouraged students to ask questions and never made anyone feel bad about not understanding (i.e. she never said anything along the lines of "this is simple stuff. do the homework and study more."). Way too many students just accept that they are "not math people" and struggle through the required core curriculum, and it seems as if many professors accept this, too. USC needs more teachers like Candace.
- I really enjoyed having Candace as a professor. She was great at simplifying things to make them easier to understand and had good pronunciation
