

Virginia Tech Regional Mathematics Contest

(Saturday, October 28, 2006)

The 28th Annual Virginia Tech Regional Mathematics Contest will be held on Saturday, October 28, 2006 from 9:00 AM - 11:30 AM. The exam will be given on many campuses throughout the Southeast including USC.

This contest was initially conceived as a regional preliminary contest to the annual national William Lowell Putnam Mathematics Competition. It is sponsored each fall by the Mathematics Department at Virginia Tech. Last year 370 students participated, representing 64 colleges and universities. The contest provides cash awards having a total value of \$750.
