Are you a Junior majoring in math, science, or engineering sciences interested in teaching high school math and science in a high needs South Carolina school?

There is a **scholarship** available to fund your remaining education.

Starting Spring 2011, up to **\$10,000** a year for up to 3 years (junior, senior, and Master of Teaching year). For every year of funding, the recipient must teach for two years in a SC high needs school.

Undergraduate Educational Courses needed: All Master of Teaching (MT) candidates must have completed EDFN 300, EDTE 400, EDPY 401, EDPY 401P, EDTE 402, and EDTE 402P before the end of your senior year. A companion scholarship 1-credit course (EDSE 310, 410) must also be taken each year. (<u>http://www.ed.sc.edu/ite/ite/MT.htm</u>)
