## Contest Rules

Contestants will participate in 3 rounds of competition. Points will be awarded after each round. (See Below) The contestant with the most points at the end of all 3 rounds will be awarded First Place ( $\$ 20$ gift card to Barnes\&Noble), the contestant with the next most points will receive Second Place ( $\$ 10$ gift card to Barnes\&Noble), and the contestant with the third most points will receive Third Place ( $\$ 5$ gift card to Barnes\&Noble).

## * Round 1: The Most

Contestants will work to solve as many puzzles (up to 8) as they can in 20 minutes. You will receive 0.5 points for each puzzle that is both complete and correct. Partially completed puzzles will not receive any credit.

* Round 2: Fastest

Contestants will work to solve one puzzle as quickly as possible. The fastest contestant receives 4 points, next fastest receives 3 points, next fastest receives 2 points, and $4^{\text {th }}$ fastest receives 1 point. Keep working! Remember the puzzles have to be completely correct to receive credit. This round will be over once 4 people have completed the puzzle correctly or when 20 minutes time has elapsed.

## * Round 3: Most Difficult

Contestants will work to fill the boxes of a ridiculously difficult puzzle. You will have 20 minutes to complete as many squares as possible. You will receive 0.5 points for each completed square, however, no incorrect squares are allowed in this round. If you have any square incorrect, you will not receive any points for this round.
