1. Change permissions of your home directory

```
chmod 0755 ~
```

2. Create public_html folder in your home directory

```
mkdir ~/public_html
```

3. Change permissions of your public_html directory

```
chmod 755 ~/public_html
```

4. Add content to your public_html (space counts towards your quota)

5. **IMPORTANT:** This will likely allow other users in the file system to read files in your home directory. Please make permissions accordingly.
