 - 1. Change permissions of your home directory

chmod 0755 ~

2. Create public html folder in your home directory

mkdir ~/public_html

3. Change permissions of your public html directory

chmod 755 ~/public_html

- 4. Add content to your public_html (space counts towards your quota)
- 5. IMPORTANT: This will likely allow other users in the file system to read files in your home directory. Please materials permissions accordingly.
