

1. Write on the blackboard:

Quiz 1 is Tuesday, 1/13. The quiz consists of one assigned HW problem from section 1.1 or 1.3.

Quiz 2 is Tuesday, 1/20. The quiz consists of one assigned HW problem from section 1.4 or 1.6.

See my website for the problems I have assigned.
